##### 1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 To refer an application by Timothy Martin Hemmings in respect of the business trading as Simply Pleasure.com, seeking to renew the licence granted to the business operating at 156 Sidwell Street Exeter. This licence was granted in February 2010 under the provisions of the above legislation.

##### 2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 This application is for the renewal of the existing licence to trade from 156 Sidwell Street. There have been one incident relating to non-compliance with conditions since the premises was first licensed. This related to an inner door being left open providing opportunity for the public to look into the premises. This was dealt with and ceased as soon as the matter was brought to the attention of the management.
- 2.2 The application has been advertised in accordance with the legislation and objections invited to be submitted. None have been received and therefore the application may be renewed.
