Report of: Environmental Health and Licensing Manager.

Type of Application: GRANT of a licence relating to a Private Hire vehicle over 4 years old.

Legislation: Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976 Town Police Clauses Act 1847

Applicant: Mohammad S RAHMAN

1. What is the report about?

1.1 An application has been received from the Applicant, a licensed taxi driver seeking permission for the grant of a private hire vehicle licence for a vehicle which is over 4 years old at the renewal date. This is a matter that cannot be dealt with under delegated powers.

2. Background

2.1 The vehicle that is being presented for licensing as a Private Hire Vehicle (PHV) is a 4 passenger Skoda Octavia with a registration date of 26 September 2013, this makes the vehicle over 4 years old. The vehicle has previously held a Hackney Carriage Vehicle licence with East Devon District Council and the applicant would like to licence the vehicle as a PHV with Exeter City Council as he has recently obtained a dual drivers licence with Exeter City Council.

3. Report details:

- 3.1 The vehicle is a Skoda Octavia registration FX63 MUU. The vehicle has a current MOT certificate dated 16 May 2018, the MOT was clear except for one advisory regarding the brake pads. The mileage recorded at the MOT was 101,020. The MOT is attached as Appendix A. In addition to the MOT certificate an independent mechanical inspection report has been submitted, this is dated 16 May 2018 and is attached as Appendix B. The Applicant presented the vehicle to the Licensing officer for inspection on 22 May 2018 and was considered to be in very good condition. Photos of the vehicle are attached as Appendix C.
- 3.2 The Licensing Sub-Committee must have regard to the Council's the Practices and Procedures for the control of Hackney Carriage and Private Hire Vehicles, Drivers and Operators and the Code of Conduct for Licensed Drivers ('Taxi Policy').
- 3.3 The Policy states that 'An application for the grant of a first private hire vehicle licence, where the vehicle in question is more than 4 years old, shall not be granted. However the applicant will be given the right to apply for the application to be considered by a licensing sub-committee if they feel that their particular circumstances justify a deviation from the existing Policies'.

4. What are the legal aspects?

4.1 Section 48(1) of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976 ('the Act') states that a district council may on receipt of an application from the proprietor of any vehicle for the grant in respect of such vehicle of a licence to use the vehicle as a private hire vehicle, grant in respect thereof a vehicle licence:

Provided that a district council shall not grant such a licence unless they are satisfied-

a) that the vehicle is-

- i) suitable in type, size and design for use as a private hire vehicle;
- ii) not of such design and appearance as to lead any person to believe that the vehicle is a hackney carriage;
- iii) in a suitable mechanical condition;
- iv) safe; and
- v) comfortable;

b) that there is in force in relation to the use of the vehicle a policy of insurance or such security as complies with the requirements of Part VI of the Road Traffic Act 1988,

and shall not refuse such a licence for the purpose of limiting the number of vehicles in respect of which such licence are granted by the council.

- 4.2 Under Section 48(4)(c) of the Act the Licensing Sub-Committee may grant a licence for a maximum period of 12 months.
- 4.3 Any person aggrieved by a refusal of the Licensing Sub-Committee to grant a vehicle licence under Section 48 of the Act may appeal to the Magistrates Court within 21 days of receiving written notice of the refusal.

5. Recommendations:

5.1 The Licensing Sub-Committee are asked to determine the application having regard to current policy.

NOTES FOR GUIDANCE

- 15 Saloon and hatchbacks must be fitted with 3 rear seatbelts. People carriers etc must have a belt for every seat.
- 18 The vehicle should have 4 doors and boot or rear tailgate. All doors and windows should work correctly.
- 19 The fire extinguisher should be readily available for use in emergency and of a suitable type.
- 22 The First Aid Kit should contain suitable items for use by passengers.
- 23 The body interior including the boot should be in a clean condition with the seats and floor properly covered and maintained fit for public service.
- 24 The Hackney plate number must be displayed inside the vehicle (on tariff card)

- 25 A meter must be fitted and display the correct tariff 1, 2 and 3. A copy of the current tariffs is attached. It should be checked over a measured distance and time.
- 26 A tariff sheet must be displayed and clearly visible to passengers.
- 27 The body exterior should be free from damage and in a clean condition.
- 28 A roof sign must be displayed.
- 55 The Hackney plate must be fixed to the **outside** rear of the vehicle on, above or below the bumper and must not be defaced or illegible.
- 56 Advertising is allowed on the front doors only. Maximum size must not exceed 70cm x 35cm.

NB As from 1 July 2007 'No Smoking' signs should be displayed to comply with The Health Act (2006).
