# 32 FINAL DETERMINATION - REVIEW OF A PERSONAL LICENCE FOLLOWING CONVICTION OF A RELEVANT OFFENCE

The Licensing Sub Committee received the report to make a final determination for the Personal Licence holder, following the hearing of the Licensing Sub Committee held on 14 October 2021. At that meeting, the Licensing Sub-committee proposed in principle to not revoke or suspend the Personal Licence.

A notice was sent to the Chief Constable of Devon and Cornwall Police on the 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2021, requesting any objections or representations to be provided within 14 days. A response was received on the 26th October 2021 indicating that there were no representations or objections from the police.

The Principal Licensing Officer stated that he had notified the Licence Holder of the hearing and confirmed that the Licence Holder had also spoken with the Police in relation to their response.

Members considered the evidence and the decision made in principle at the hearing on 14 October 2021 and that there were no objections or representations received from the Chief Constable of Devon and Cornwall Police. Members unanimously supported the decision to not revoke or suspend the Personal Licence and for the Licensing Authority to give notice of the decision to the licence holder and Chief Constable of Devon and Cornwall Police.
