Cllr Robson has forwarded your complaint about sewage odour to me. Could you let me know your address and the times that the odour is occurring so that I can log the complaint? I am in regular contact with SWW's Waste Water Operations Manager and can discuss this matter with him directly.

Representatives from Environmental Health and the Environment Agency, together with local Councillors and residents' representatives meet with SWW at a liaison group every 3 months. We discuss operation of the works and the number of complaints received; any information that you can supply is therefore very useful.

SWW has recently set up Proactive Team, based at the works. The team sends out regular updates of any planned works, breakdowns etc. by text. They can also be contacted during office hours and should be able to visit and witness the odour as they are based locally. If you'd like to contact the team and/or be added to their text alert system, their number is 07779606026.

A complainant's been on the telephone today, reporting odour yesterday (1st July) at Countess Wear School 09:45 - for a couple of hours and at his home - a strong, sudden odour at 16:20.

I've had a couple of other complaints recently

- " Newport Park complainant alleges that, for the last 3 weekends, the odour has been bad from 18:00 onwards but is not a problem Monday to Thursday.
- " Newport Road bad 'day & night'. Noticed in the early hours of the morning, when she alleges that the odour woke her up.
- " Wear Barton Road (cul de sac end) odour all day on Saturday 27th June from 10:30 onwards. Definitely not coming from the inspection chamber in the field.
- " Countess Wear Road (Bridge Road end) complainant has been keeping a log since February. Numerous occasions when the odour comes & goes quickly but lingers in her house. Particularly bad around 07:00 & 19:00.

For the past month:

- " Wednesday 3rd June, 07:00 & 19:30
- " Monday 15th June 07:00
- " Tuesday 23rd June 06:30
- " Wednesday 24th June 06:30 to 13:00 (ties in with scraper failure)

Weekends & out of hours odours seem to be a common issue here, so I do think it's worth pursuing how members of the public can contact the works during these times.
