### **APPLICATION TO RENEW HACKNEY CARRIAGE / PRIVATE HIRE VEHICLE LICENCE OVER 9 YEARS OLD**

The Chair noted that the Applicant was not in attendance. The Licensing Officer explained that this was due to a calendar mix-up. Panel members decided unanimously to proceed without the Applicant.

The Licensing Officer presented the application for a licensed driver to renew a Hackney Carriage Vehicle licence in relation to a four passenger Toyota Prius, which was over nine years old at the renewal date. The vehicle was first registered on 31 January 2015. The Applicant had submitted a current vehicle MOT certificate dated 17 July 2024 with a mileage of 223,065 miles and the MOT history showing that the vehicle had failed six times since 2016. An independent mechanical inspection report, was also submitted, dated 5 August 2024, along with photographs of the vehicle. The vehicle was also inspected by a Licensing Officer and was considered to be in good condition.

Members noted that all advisable repairs had been carried out and that the applicant was responsive and had a good relationship with licensing officers.

**RESOLVED** that the application for the renewal of a Hackney Carriage Vehicle licence be granted for 12 months. A further MOT should also be carried out after six months.
