1. WHAT IS THE REPORT ABOUT?

1.1 To determine whether the Applicant is a fit and proper person to hold a taxi drivers licence.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 The Applicant submitted an application attached at APPENDIX A for the renewal of a Hackney Carriage / Private Hire driver's licence on 15th April 2025.
- 2.2 The Applicant failed to disclose the following convictions on the renewal application.
 - TS10 Failing to comply with traffic light signals 24th December 2024: 3 penalty points
- 2.3 A copy of the Applicant's DBS is attached at APPENDIX B.
- 2.4 A copy of the Applicant's Taxi Plus is attached at APPENDIX C.
- 2.5 A copy of the Notice of Prosecution is attached at APPENDIX D.

3. WHAT ARE THE LEGAL ASPECTS?

- 3.1 Under Section 61 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976 ('the Act') a district council may suspend or revoke or (on application therefore under section 46 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 ('Act of 1847') or section 51 of this Act, as the case may be) refuse to renew the licence of a driver of a hackney carriage or private hire vehicle on any of the following grounds:
 - (a) that he has since the grant of the licence—

- (i) been convicted of an offence involving dishonesty, indecency or violence; or
- (ii) been convicted of an offence under or has failed to comply with the provisions of the Act of 1847 or of this Part of this Act;
- (a) that he has since the grant of the licence been convicted of an immigration offence or required to pay an immigration penalty; or
- (b) any other reasonable cause.
- 3.2 The Licensing Sub-Committee must have regard to the Statutory taxi and private hire standards updated on 25th November 2022 and issued by the Secretary of State for Transport under section 177(1) of the Policing and Crime Act 2017('Statutory Guidance')
- 3.3 The Statutory Guidance provides information on the fit and proper test at Paragraph 5.4 states:

'Licensing authorities have a duty to ensure that any person to whom they grant a taxi or private hire vehicle driver's licence is a fit and proper person to be a licensee. It may be helpful when considering whether an applicant or licensee is fit and proper to pose oneself the following question:

Without any prejudice, and based on the information before you, would you allow a person for whom you care, regardless of their condition, to travel alone in a vehicle driven by this person at any time of day or night?

If, on the balance of probabilities, the answer to the question is no, the individual should not hold a licence.'

3.4 The Licensing Sub-Committee may impose penalty points in accordance with the Council's Taxi Policy which is explained further below.

4. WHAT ARE THE POLICY ASPECTS?

- 4.1 The Licensing Sub-Committee must have regard to the Council's the Practices and Procedures for the control of Hackney Carriage and Private Hire Vehicles, Drivers and Operators and the Code of Conduct for Licensed Drivers ('Taxi Policy').
- 4.2 Section 13.3.1: Private hire drivers (or dual Hackney carriage/ private hire licence holders), who are convicted of any criminal or motoring offence, shall disclose the conviction and the penalty involved to the Council within seven days. For these purposes, a fixed penalty motoring offence amounts to a conviction.
- 4.3 Section E.9.1: Normally, convictions for other traffic offences not involving disqualification should not prevent someone obtaining a licence. However, if there are several convictions for these types of offence, an applicant will normally be expected not to have been convicted of an offence in the 6 months before an application is made.

4.4 In July 2023, the Council adopted a points based disciplinary system which officers and the Licensing Sub-Committee may apply to licensed drivers. A copy is attached as Appendix E to this report.

Relevant to this report, the following can be considered.

Details of Misconduct	Points applicable
Failure to notify the Council in writing, of any motoring or criminal convictions within 21 days or conviction or cautions during period of current licence	6

- 4.5 When issued, the penalty points will remain 'live' for a rolling period of 36 months from the date they were imposed.
- 4.6 If 12 penalty points are imposed on an individual licence in any one 36-month rolling period the driver will appear in front of the Licensing Sub-Committee where appropriate action will be taken in accordance with the Taxi Policy.

5. OPTIONS

5.1 The Licensing Authority would make the following recommendations:

The Licensing Sub-Committee may find either:


- i) That the Applicant is <u>not</u> a fit and proper person to hold a taxi driver's licence and his licence should not be renewed.
- ii) That the Applicant is a fit and proper person to hold a taxi driver's licence and the licence should be renewed; or
- iii) That the Applicant is a fit and proper person to hold a taxi drivers' licence and the licence should be renewed but one or more of the following sanctions shall apply;
 - a. a written warning shall be issued by the Chair of the Licensing Sub Committee with regard to future conduct;
 - b. penalty points shall be issued in accordance with the Licensing Authority penalty points disciplinary system;
 - c. the Applicant must attend and complete a suitable training course to the satisfaction of the Licensing Authority.

6. RECOMMENDED

6.1 It is recommended that the Licensing Sub-Committee determine whether or not the Applicant is a fit and proper person to hold a taxi driver's licence, having regard to the Licensed Drivers' representations and all other relevant information submitted together with the Taxi Policy. 1. WHAT IS THE REPORT ABOUT?

- 1.1 The Applicant submitted an application attached at APPENDIX A for the grant of a Hackney Carriage / Private Hire driver's licence on 25th July 2024, during the application process the following convictions have been disclosed:
 - SP50 Exceeding speed limit on a motorway on 29th June 2023: 5 Points. SP50 Exceeding speed limit on a motorway on 4th July 2023: 3 Points.
- 1.2 A copy of the Applicant's DBS certificate is attached at APPENDIX B.
- 1.3 The Applicant has provided references, attached at APPENDIX C.
- 1.4 A check of the Applicant's driving licence was conducted showed: 8 penalty points and the Davis result is attached at APPENDIX D.
- 1.5 The Applicant completed a Taxi Driver Assessment. The certificate is attached at APPENDIX E.

2. WHAT ARE THE LEGAL ASPECTS?

2.1 Section 51 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976 ('the Act') provides that subject to the provisions of this Part of this Act, a district council shall, on the receipt of an application from any person for the grant to that person of a licence to drive private hire vehicles, grant to that person a driver's licence:

Provided that a district council shall not grant a licence—

- (a) unless they are satisfied
- (i) that the applicant is a fit and proper person to hold a driver's licence;

- 2.2 Section 59 Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976 provides that a district council shall not grant a licence to drive a hackney carriage—
 - (a) unless they are satisfied —
 - (i) that the applicant is a fit and proper person to hold a driver's licence;
- 2.3 The evidential burden is on the Applicant to show on the balance of probabilities that they are a fit and proper person to hold a Private Hire/Hackney Carriage drivers' licence. Therefore, the Applicant must demonstrate to the Licensing Sub-Committee that they are a fit and proper person to be a Private Hire/Hackney Carriage licence holder.
- 2.4 The Licensing Sub-Committee must have regard to the Statutory taxi and private hire standards updated on 25th November 2022 and issued by the Secretary of State for Transport under section 177(1) of the Policing and Crime Act 2017('Statutory Guidance').
- 2.5 Paragraph 5.4 of the Statutory Guidance states:
- 2.5.1 Licensing authorities have a duty to ensure that any person to whom they grant a taxi or private hire vehicle driver's licence is a fit and proper person to be a licensee. It may be helpful when considering whether an applicant or licensee is fit and proper to pose oneself the following question:
- 2.5.2 Without any prejudice, and based on the information before you, would you allow a person for whom you care, regardless of their condition, to travel alone in a vehicle driven by this person at any time of day or night?

If, on the balance of probabilities, the answer to the question is no, the individual should not hold a licence.

3. WHAT ARE THE POLICY ASPECTS?

- 3.1 The Licensing Sub-Committee must have regard to the Council's the Practices and Procedures for the control of Hackney Carriage and Private Hire Vehicles, Drivers and Operators and the Code of Conduct for Licensed Drivers ('Taxi Policy').
- 3.2 E.9.1 States that 'Normally, convictions for other traffic offences not involving disqualification should not prevent someone obtaining a licence. However, if there are several convictions for these types of offence, an applicant will normally be expected not to have been convicted of an offence in the 6 months before an application is made'.
- 3.3 The Licensing Sub-Committee must satisfy itself that all Licensed Drivers are Fit and Proper persons to hold a Drivers Licence. In so doing, it will have regard to all relevant factors such as convictions, cautions, warnings and reprimands including those that are "spent Convictions" under the Rehabilitation of Offenders Act 1974.

3.4 The Taxi Policy does state that there may be occasions where it is appropriate to depart from these guidelines when considering whether a driver is fit and proper. For example, where the offence is a 'one-off' and there are mitigating circumstances or alternatively where there are many or continuous offences which may show a pattern of offending and unfitness.

4. INSTITUTE OF LICENSING GUIDANCE

- 4.1 The Institute of Licensing Guidance on Suitability for applicants and licensees in the hackney carriage and private hire industry published in October 2024 states the following:
- 4.2 Para 4.50 'Tax and private hire drivers are professional drivers charged with the responsibility of carrying the public. Any motoring conviction can demonstrate a lack of professionalism and will be considered seriously. A single occurrence of a minor traffic offence may not prohibit the grant of a licence or result in action against an existing licence. Subsequent convictions suggest the fact that the licensee may not take their professional responsibilities seriously and may therefore note be a safe and suitable person to be granted or retain a licence.'
- 4.3 Para 4.54 'By attaining 7 or more penalty points on their DVLA licence a driver is demonstrating they may not be fit and proper and the authority should assess their suitability. It is suggested part of the assessment is to undertake a driver awareness course and/or pass a driver assessment, with no more than 8 minor infringements, within 2 months of notice from the authority they are considering the suitability of the licence holder. Failure to do so strongly suggests the driver is not fit and proper and not be licensed until a period of 12 months has passed with no further convictions and has passed a driver assessment since the last conviction.'

5. OPTIONS

- 5.1 The Licensing Sub-Committee may find either:
 - i) that the Applicant is a fit and proper person to hold a taxi driver's licence; or
 - ii) that the Applicant is not a fit and proper person to hold a taxi driver's licence.

6. RECOMMENDED

6.1 It is recommended that the Licensing Sub-Committee determine whether or not the Applicant is a fit and proper person to hold a driver's licence, having regard to the submitted information and the Council's Taxi Policy.
