Sitting in my home with windows closed I can smell the stench of raw sewage, it is really unacceptable. I have avoided going outside for that reason as it makes one feel rather sick. I do believe it is massively due to all the homes being built in the area and the water treatment works not being able to cope with it all. I have had someone from your office visit me before and I would like to see someone again on this matter as they were totally on the case of making South West water and persimmon homes accountable at the time. It really made a difference and the stench has been so much less since your involvement.
