

## Representation in Respect of Requested Licence Variations- the Star Inn, Whipton, Exeter, Devon

*Any external bar will operate for the sale and supply of alcohol until 23:00h on any day.*

- **Any external bar will operate for the sale and supply of alcohol until 21:00 on any given day with the outside area this being cleared of people by 21:30.**
- **Save for access to and egress from the premises the use of gardens, patios and any future external play areas will not commence before the 09.00 hours and will cease at 21:30 hours.**
- **No music or speech will be relayed by external speakers without the consent of the licensing authority.**
- **The use of lighting in the gardens, patios and external areas will cease at 21:30 hours, except for health and safety or security reasons.**

*When the sale of alcohol takes place within external area, regular checks of the garden will include the removal of empty glasses and bottles.*

*Whenever the external area is used for licensable activities, a sufficient number of staff members, which will be determined on a risk assessed basis, will operate, monitor and supervise the area for customer behaviour and to monitor noise levels.*

*After 4.00pm a minimum of 2 members of staff shall be working the bar when the premises are open for licensable activities, at least one of whom must be a personal licence holder.*

**One person after 16:00hrs provided they hold a personal licence until 19:00hrs when a minimum of 2 members of staff shall be working the premises whilst open for licensable activities, one of which must be a personal licence holder.**

*The applicant wishes to replace this condition with the following: "The DPS will be responsible for drafting and implementing a written door supervisor risk assessment ('the assessment'). The assessment will determine whether door supervisors are required to promote the licensing objectives and will employ door supervisors in the numbers and at the times identified by the assessment. The assessment will be made available to Police and Licensing officers on request. ~~and will be updated periodically as required to ensure best practice.~~ **replace with said assessment will be subject to a full review every quarter. Immediate action will be taken should there be seen to be evidence to suggest SIA trained Door staff are required.***

As the application states, all other hours, activities and conditions currently permitted by the licence are to remain the same.
