Heavitree Social Club have been given the opportunity to put these matters right but this has not happened. There have been a number of loud amplified music events so far this year which are advertised online and Facebook, and I see no reason why they won't continue.

Where amplified music is to be played organisers will need to demonstrate in a noise risk assessment that the programme of events has been planned to minimise the impact on the noise sensitive premises identified. Any measures to mitigate the noise levels from the music sources must be considered such as amplified music is not to be played outside, keeping doors and windows closed to limit noise, and compressors or limiters are used on sound system to control sound levels. Set maximum levels for the low frequency levels (bass) as these cause the most disturbance to local residents. Seek advice from a competent sound engineer.
