Add-in the large crowds coming and going to music, dance & other non-rugby events, the potential for crime/disorder/nuisance and problems with public safety is inevitable. This application represents a major variation to operations at Sandy Park Stadium rather than the simple one it has been proposed under and as such requires greater detailed consideration.</p>
